STATEMENT OF WORK

1.1 PROJECT SUMMARY

Chester County EMS Council, Inc. (EMS Council) is seeking requests for information from qualified and strategic firms to provide an electronic Patient Care Report System (ePCR) for EMS agencies that are headquartered in Chester County, Pennsylvania.

1.2 GOALS

The EMS Council is in the process of evaluating its current ePCR provider to ensure that they are offering the most up-to-date, user-friendly, economical product available. The EMS Council is seeking an ePCR software that will fulfill all patient care report requirements as established by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Bureau of EMS. In addition, The EMS Council desires an ePCR software to enhance reporting, quality assurance, and billing capabilities.

1.3 BACKGROUND/SYSTEM INFORMATION

There are currently 30 licensed EMS agencies that are headquartered in Chester County who would be potential users of the ePCR platform. These 30 agencies include QRS, BLS, IALS, and ALS level agencies providing both 911 and non-911 responses. Anticipated annual ePCR volume is approximately 60,000. The ePCR platform would need to accommodate any changes in agency level of service or additional licensed EMS agencies. Each participating agency would require administrative level access for agency level configuration, and the regional EMS council would also require administrative level access for regional level configuration.

1.4 SCOPE OF WORK

Minimum Required & Optional Features:

- All products and modules are on the exact same platform, no third-party applications (including reporting) utilized to provide a total solution. Single sign on access to all modules.
- Admin configuration of Forms, Workflow, Questions, Reports, and Dashboards
- Provide the ability to use templates from other customers without having to be recreated

- Report permissions, including end-users, with access permissions whereby report users can create and view individual performance measures.
- Agency configurable data input workflow allowing each customer to create a different user experience.
- Data Manager that allows the service to decide what choices are available in every Event Visibility feature allowing customers to create an 'if this, then that' response to data input requirements.
- Expanded permissions to allow each agency on a shared system to create validation rules above the system data collection requirements.
- Validation engine controlled by system administration so each customer can have a completely different set of required fields and not be held to a 'one size fits all' solution.
- Multiple input workflow to allow client to design multiple workflows or input templates
- Optional Mobile Integrated Health (MIH) integration and/or modules for licensed EMS agencies also providing MIH services.

- EKG device data interface/capability, cloud integration as well (specifically useful for non-Windows devices). EKG integration allows for multiple monitor cases to be merged with a single ePCR, not limited to one case per incident.
- Cloud integration also permits merging case files with ePCR on desktop computers, users are not required to return to mobile device.
- Offline run form Tablet agnostic mobile application. Data caching technology allows for use across most existing tablets and computers.
- Configurable Printed PCR designed by the agency
- Worksheets provide grouped service defined questions onto one page when they are part of the same document. Users can quickly and easily collect AMA information or complete an ABN form. Custom signature sections can be included and can be included in the PDF printout. Any supplemental form the client may still be doing on paper can be recreated in digital form as a worksheet.

Reporting:
